CHALK RIVER, Ont. (CP)—A top Canadian nuclear scientist says Canada probably could make atomic bombs but has no desire to do so. "I presume we could make an atomic bomb because no one has tried to make one has failed," Dr. Wilfrid B. Lewis, vice-president for research and development of Atomic Energy of Canada Limited, said in an interview at the government's huge atomic project here. But Dr. Lewis said Canada's atomic program is related to peaceful application of atomic energy.
