CF-105 Jet
Cost 89 Million

OTTAWA (CP) — The federal government spent \$89,640,000 up to Oct. 31 on development of the CF-105 supersonic jet interceptor and is committed to support its development until next Oct. 1, Defence Minister Peakes informed the Commons Saturday.

He said the total cost of the project, undertaken by Avro Aircraft Limited, will depend on "the number of aircraft, if any, which are ordered."

Replying to CCF questioners, Peakes said the delta-winged interceptor is designed to meet high-altitude manned bombers, Russia had a considerable number of such bombers and it was necessary to have aircraft capable of meeting them.

He said the total cost of the project will be reviewed before next Oct. 1 in the light of the likely threat from guided missiles.

Eight CF-105 prototypes were being developed, but not all would be in the air by next Oct. 1. The defence department would be able to discontinue the development project then if circumstances warranted.

The CF-105—called the Arrow—was unveiled by Avro last Oct. 4.

Disagree On Nfld. Ferry

OTTAWA (CP)—Transport Minister Hees and a Newfoundland Liberal disagreed Saturday on whether the ferry William Carson can load and unload automobiles at Argenta, Nfld.

Leonard T. Stick, Trinity-Conception, said in the Commons it has been proved this can be done. He asked Mr. Hees to carry out a "promise" that the William Carson start carrying automobiles.

Mr. Hees said the CNC, which operates the ferry has said there are a number of reasons which make it difficult, if not impossible, to load automobiles at Argenta.

The ferry, built to operate between North Sydney, N.S., and Port Aux Basques, Nfld., has been using the Argenta harbor because of harbor problems at Port Aux Basques.
