New Data On Earth's Core

TORONTO (AP)—Shock waves from A-bombs and H-bombs have disclosed secrets of the makeup of the earth's depths, an Australian scientist reported Tuesday.

And some day one or more A-bombs will be intentionally set off underground just to learn more about the bowels of the earth, Professor K. E. Bullen of the University of Sydney predicted.

Shock waves from atomic and H-bombs travel deep into the earth and back to the surface again.

Studies of shock waves from four British bombs in Australia last year gave additional evidence, all indirect, that the earth's heart is a solid core of nickel an iron 1,600 miles thick, Dr. Bullen told the International Union of Geodesy and Geophysics.

Atomic blasts could be used to get more precise and very valuable information about the earth's crust and deep depths below, Professor Bullen said.

Seismologists two years ago proposed to the United States, Russia and Britain that one to four A-bombs be used this way, he said, but there is no green light yet.
