# Canada Bank Interest Falls To 5.18 Percent

OTTAWA (CP) — The Bank of Canada interest rate Thursday marked up its fifth consecutive weekly decline, falling to 5.18 per cent from 1.26 last week with the sale of \$115,000,000 in 91-day government treasury bills.

The rate now has fallen almost a full point in the five weeks since Sept. 17 when it stood at 6.13 per cent.

The bank rate — minimum charge by the central bank on its infrequent loans to chartered banks — is set at one-quarter of one per cent above the average

## Parishioners Imprison Priest

PIZZOLANO, Italy (Reuters) — Police threw tear gas bombs here Wednesday to disperse more than 500 villagers who, as a sign of affection, tried to "wall up" their parish priest in his church.

The entire adult population of the village turned out, many with pitchforks, to prevent the departure of popular priest Saverio Della Mura, due to leave Pizzolano Wednesday for another post.

Villagers blocked up all the church doors and windows with tables held in position by severed telegraph poles. The priest set waiting car was carried away by the strongest men in the village and locked in a barn.

Police arrived on the scene and threw the tear-gas bombs after unsuccessfully appealing to the villagers to go home.

When the priest emerged from the church, he said the demonstration had persuaded him to stay and he would ask the archbishop of nearby Salerno to annul the posting.

His new post was to be in Mercato San Severino, a town of 20,000 inhabitants, nearly 40 times larger than Pizzolano.

yield on the weekly sale of 91-day treasury bills.

The bank announced Thursday that \$111,000,000 of the bills were sold by tender at an average price of \$98.796 for an average yield of 4.93 per cent. The highest yield was 4.97 per cent and the lowest .35.

**REFLECTS CONDITIONS**

The bank rate is considered a general reflection of conditions in the short-term money market, since its level is tied to the weekly rate of government short-term borrowings.

This was the first time since May 28 that the average yield on treasury bill sales had fallen below five per cent.

Thursday's bank rate of 5.18 per cent compares with the record high of 6.41 per cent on Aug. 13 and the record low of 1.12 per cent on July 31 last year.

The government also sold \$20,000,000 in 182-day treasury bills at an average price of \$97.397 to yield 5.36 per cent. Highest yield was 5.41 per cent and lowest was 5.28. Last week the average yield on a similar sale was 5.51 per cent.

The sale of a total \$135,000,000 in the two maturities of treasury bills equals the amount of bills falling due this week. A similar amount of bills will be offered for sale next week.

## Waivers Asked On Gus Zernial

DETROIT (AP) — Detroit Tigers asked waivers Wednesday on 36-year-old Gus Zernial "for the purpose of giving him his outright release."

Unless he is claimed by some other American League club by Monday, the utility infielder-outfielder will be eligible for release. Zernial batted .227 and hit seven home runs last season.

## CONTRACT BRIDGE

West dealer. South-South vulnerability.

The bidding:

West North East South  
Pass Pass 3♦ 4NT  
5♦ 6♣ Pass 6NT

South won the nine with the queen. He cashed six spade tricks and produced this position:

**West** ♠ A Q ♣ 8 7 6  
**East** ♠ 9 2 ♣ 10 5

Declarer now tried to run the clubs. When the suit failed to break 3-3, he was finished. He went down one.

But he should have made the hand. All he had to do was first cash the ace of diamonds. West would then have been in bad shape for a discard. He would very likely have released the queen of hearts. South could then lead a heart and thus make the slam.

At the other table, against the same preemptive bid, South bid four diamonds. When North responded five clubs, South bid five spades and North carried on to six. The spade slam was easily made for a 1,530-point score. Declarer was able to establish an extra club trick by ruffing one of dummy's low clubs. His team gained 1,630 points on the deal.
