

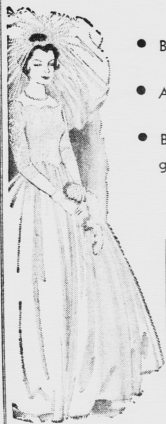

## Early planing is needed for wedding photographs

A picture is worth a thousand words an old proverb maintains. This is nowhere more true than for wedding pictures.

But, appointments with your photographer should be made well in advance particularly if the bride wishes formal posed pictures of herself as well as a complete photographic record of the wedding itself.

The photographer will work closely with the happy couple as the wedding day begins and in a few short days will be able to provide a photographic report that will be reviewed time and again over the years

as a reminder of an exceedingly happy event.

Photographic experts say there are three elements that guarantee perfection of a wedding photograph: vast advances in photographic techniques, natural rather than the stiff stereotyped portraits and the elegant wedding gowns of today.

But arranging for the portrait takes time. Lights must be arranged to capture depth, to balance light against shadow, to bring out the fabric of the gown and to decide on the most attractive facial angle.

Experts say an appointment for a sitting should be made just as soon as the gown is ready and well before the bride is in the middle of the swirl of pre wedding partying.

Some hints for successful picture taking:

Since sheet may be seen in the photo, they should be of the latest fashion. For make-up use liquid base nearest your skin tone. Brows should be arched naturally and lipstick line should be clean and neat. Because of the bright lights mascara should be used lightly.
