### Man Is Seized With \$132,000 In Suit Cases

CORNWALL, Ont. (CP)—A 31-year-old Verdon, Que., man has been arrested by U.S. officers across the St. Lawrence River in Massena, N.Y., as he sat on a bus bound for Albany, N.Y.

The U.S. Border Patrol said it seized \$80,000 in Canadian currency and \$52,000 in travellers' cheques in two suit cases.

U.S. officers later charged Roger Caza of Verdu, father of two, with illegal entry into the United States.

Caza was being turned over to Canadian authorities here.

In Montreal, a Bank of Montreal spokesman said an employee with access to the vaults stole \$80,000 in cash and travellers' cheques last Friday.

The spokesman said investigation of the case was headed by its own security forces.

### MAKE CHECK

The arrest came when Inspector James B. Turange Jr. of the border patrol was making a routine check of passengers aboard a bus leaving this community across the St. Lawrence River from Cornwall.

The inspector was reported to have found \$80,000 in cash and a number of \$50,000 in travellers' cheques in the suit cases. The patrol said a total of \$80,000 was in \$20 bills and \$30,000 in \$10 bills.

A border patrol official said the man had crossed into the U.S. from Canada at Niagara Falls last Saturday and travelled from there to Rochester, Syracuse and then Massena.

The official said the man had falsely identified himself at the border as a U.S. citizen.
