PUTTING IN THE WHEAT

THE SELECTION, CARE AND FERTILIZATION OF SEED. How to Avoid Rust and Smut—Why Manure on Wheat Land Should be Decomposed—The Storing of Seeds for Winter—A Variety of Farm Notes.

The wheat grown in this section is sown in the fall, followed by the selection of the best seed in the spring. While fertilizers and careful preparation of the seed are the main essentials for the wheat crop, the most important is the selection of the seed.

RUST IN WHEAT.

When seed is procured from outside sources there is a liability of bringing disease there in. Experiments made at the Indian Experiment Station demonstrate that no variety of wheat is rust proof, both the bearded and smooth kinds being equally liable.

MANURE AND FERTILIZERS.

Manure on wheat land gives excellent results, as every farmer knows, but such manure should be well decomposed, the seeds of weeds will be carried to the wheat field in the manure.

FALL ON THE FARM.

The Storing of Tubers, Cabbage and the Like for Winter Use. Turnips, parsnips, carrots and beets may be stored in pits outside of the barn, or in mounds.

Regarding the Poisoning of Fruit by Spraying with Arsenical Compounds.

It is estimated that a man must eat several dozen apples at one time in order to get a fatal dose. In storing away onions for winter use, the first thing to do is to allow them to become thoroughly dry after harvesting.

Fruit that is supposed to market in barrels, crates or large boxes may be made to give a larger profit if shipped in neat baskets.

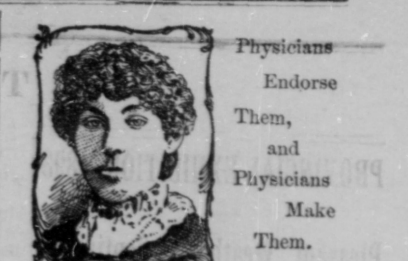
