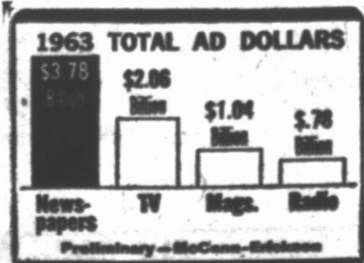
Bessie MacDonald, who is attending university in Halifax, N.S., is the holiday guest of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Colin MacDonald.
