Haddock Stocks On Grand Banks Affected
OTTAWA, Jan. 7 - (CP) - Extensive fishing by foreign vessels, notably from Spain, is depleting haddock stocks on the Grand Banks of Newfoundland, Dr. W. Templeman, director of the Newfoundland Fisheries Research Station, reported today. He told the annual meeting of the Fisheries Research Board of Canada that large numbers of Spanish trawlers, dragging in pairs, began to appear in 1950, with as many as 128 operating on the bank in 1951. The Spanish trawlers continue to fish in the haddock areas after the large fish have dispersed, salting down small haddock and fishing immature haddock which concentrate on the southeast shoal of the bank. They catch great quantities of small haddock several years before they reach the size utilized by Newfoundland fishermen. Dr. Templeman said Newfoundland fishermen, though on a smaller scale, also contribute to destruction of young haddock by discarding as too small for commercial use about 50 per cent of their catch. The poor survival of the 1942, 1944 and 1945 broods of haddock now is producing a scarcity of larger fish to replace those taken by the commercial fishery from earlier-year broods stocks. Not only was the size of haddock greatly reduced in 1951, but the landed quantities also declined. Newfoundland's haddock exports for the first six months of 1951 totalled 1,303,000 pounds against 5,703,000 in the corresponding period of 1950. However, Newfoundland trawlers turned to the catching of rosefish, plaice and cod in 1951 when they found haddock scarce and small.

OTTAWA, Jan. 7 - (CP) - Canada's official reserves of gold and United States dollars jumped \$189,000,000 to \$1,779,000,000 at Dec. 31 from \$1,610,000,000 announced today. At Dec. 31 a year ago, the holdings were \$1,742,000,000. The reserves, announced quarterly, rose steadily during the fall period. From \$1,810,000,000 at Sept. 30, they went to \$1,678,000,000 at Oct. 31, \$1,749,000,000 at Nov. 30 and \$1,779,000,000 at Dec. 31. All totals are in U.S. dollars.

The Case Of General Meyer
LONDON, Jan. 7 - The Jewish community of Canada told members of the Federal Cabinet that any advantages which might accrue to the Allied Military through the services of the Nazi General Kurt Meyer would be more than offset by the moral obloquy which would attach to his release from imprisonment for atrocities committed against Canadian soldiers. In its communication to the Rt. Hon. L. B. Pearson and Brooke Claxton, cabinet members responsible for external affairs and national defense respectively, the Canadian Jewish Congress said that the release of General Meyer would be an "insult to the hundreds of thousands of Canadian citizens who brought great sacrifices to destroy Nazism and to the memory of the millions who suffered from its infamy. To release this man who was convicted after due process of Canadian law and with the moral approval of the entire civilized world would be to aid, to comfort and to encourage the forces which are responsible for the agonies which all human society has suffered in connection with the last war. It would serve as a recurrence of world war by the establishment of a stable international order based upon justice and law. "A real fear exists among the citizens of this country that the convicted German general may soon be released. The danger of resurgence of a militaristic and Fascist Germany which would become a problem for world democracy ought surely to be of the utmost concern to this generation."
