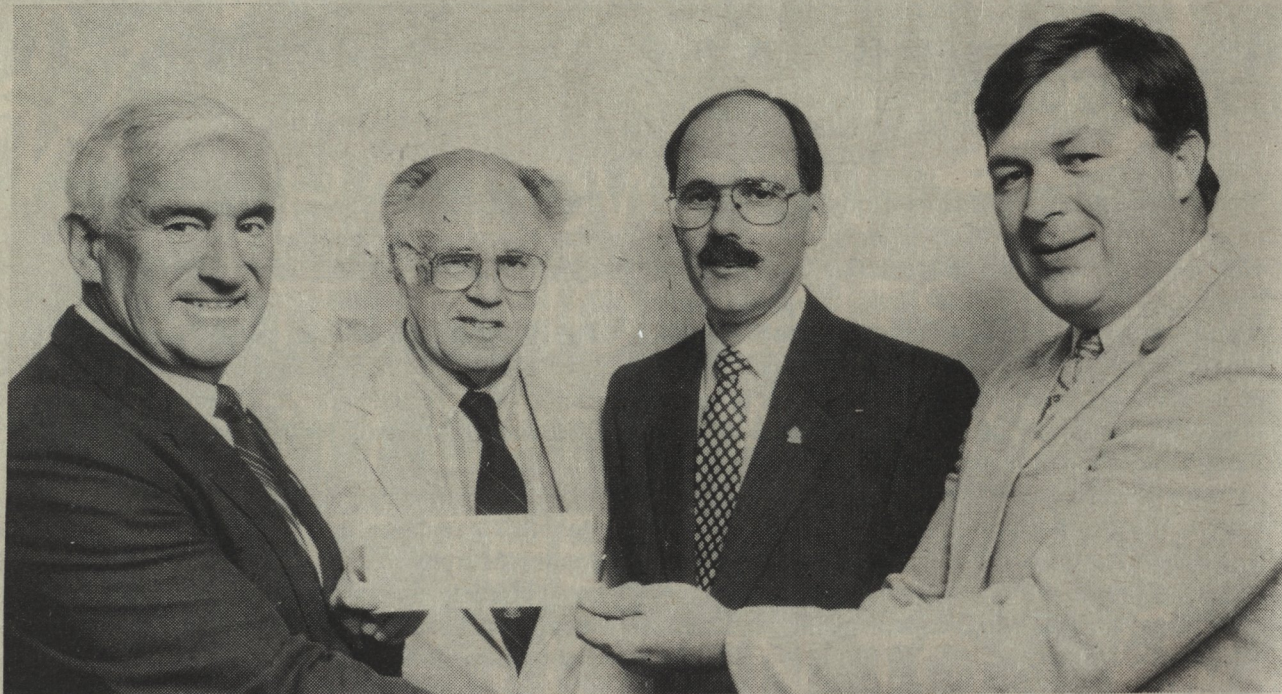

New Funds for New Cafeteria
