Recommend Wage Increase For 100
 OTTAWA (CP)—A 10-cent hourly wage increase on a \$1.28 basic rate for some 100 members of the National Catholic Syndicate of Longshoremen of Sorel, Que., was recommended in a conciliation board report issued Friday by the labor department.
 The board, consisting of Judge Andre Montpetit of the Quebec Superior Court and Leonce Plante and Marc Lapointe, both of Montreal, recommend that the increase, effective July 23 for men who are employed by a group of Sorel stevedoring companies.
 The board also recommended time and a half for night work instead of the present premium of 25 cents an hour now being paid; a boost of 20 cents an hour from 10 in the premium for foreman; and addition of the day of the Immaculate Conception, Dec. 8, to the five statutory holidays now recognized in the agreement between the syndicate and the companies.
 The board recommended against granting a syndicate request for a closed shop.

C. MacDonald, retired after many years of faithful service, has been announced by W. E. Robinson, regional vice president and general manager, C.N.R., and chairman of the Intercolonial and Prince Edward Island Railways Provident Fund Board.
 Mr. O'Brien, who is a native of Moncton, joined the railway service as a junior clerk in the pensions and staff records office in that city in October 1908, later becoming clerk, senior ledger clerk, senior insurance clerk and chief clerk in September 1943.

Stock Market Extends Rally
 NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market extended its rally in a vigorous manner Friday. It was the third straight advance.
 Leadership for the rise was first class—railroads, motors, steels, oils coppers and others all joining in the forward move.
 Total volume for the session came to 1,320,000 shares, the best since June 16.
 The Associated Press average of 60 stocks gained 90 cents and it stood at \$108.80 at the close.
 The industrial component of the average was up \$1.50, railroads up 90 cents and utilities up 10 cents.
 At the top of the most active list was Delaware Power and Light up 1-4 at 24 1-4 with 17,019 shares traded. It was followed by General Motors up 7-8 and Socony-Vacuum up 3-8.
 McIntyre led Canadian stocks on the upside, up 1-1-2. It was followed by International Nickel, ahead 1-2. Canadian Pacific, Dome Mines and Hiram Walker each advanced 1-8. Distillers Seagram fell 1-8.
 Giant Yellowknife, Canadian issue on the American stock exchange gained 1-8.
