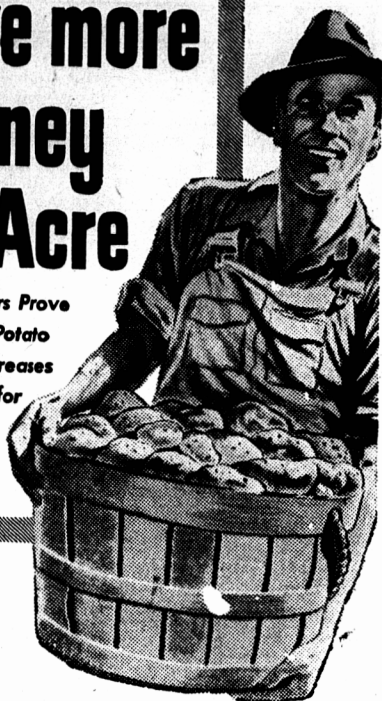

The Department reserves the right to demand from any successful tenderer, before awarding the order, a security deposit in the form of a certified cheque on a chartered bank in Canada, made payable to the order of the Honourable the Minister of Public Works equal to 10 per cent of the amount of the tender, or Bearer Bonds of the Dominion of Canada or of the Canadian National Railway Company and its constituent companies unconditionally guaranteed as to principal and interest by the Dominion of Canada, or the aforementioned bonds and a certified cheque if required to make up an odd amount.

This deposit will be refunded when such copies are returned in good condition. Specifications are also on display at the General Post Office, Summerside, P.E.I.

Each tender must be accompanied by a certified cheque on a chartered bank in Canada payable to the Receiver General of Canada, or by bearer bonds, as specified in the form of tender, for ten per cent (10%) of the amount of the tender.  
All deposits so made will be returned unless, in the case of the successful tenderer, he should decline to enter into a contract for the work when requested to do so or should fail after accepting the contract to complete the same satisfactorily.  
The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted.

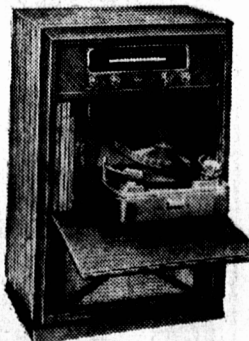

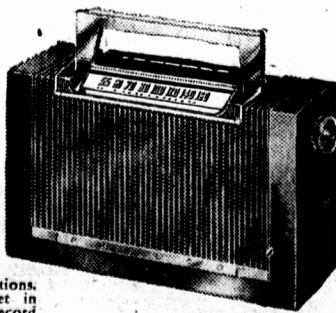
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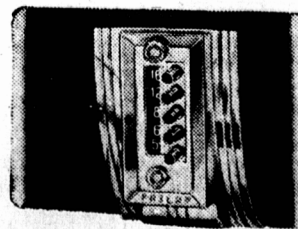
