OTTAWA (CP) - The Quebec government likely will get a recommendation soon that it take part in the federal - provincial program of campsite construction along the Trans - Canada Highway.

The recommendation would come from the provincial publicity bureau. It was learned here Wednesday that the Quebec delegation to the federal - provincial tourist conference is preparing to make a formal proposal to Robert Prevost, director of the publicity bureau.

Quebec is one of two provinces - the other being Ontario - that

have failed to enter the program under which the federal government pays half the cost of constructing camping ground and picnic sites along the Trans-Canada Highway.
