

**Abbey Memorial  
For Churchill**

LONDON (AP)—Prime Minister Wilson has announced a Winston Churchill memorial stone will soon be placed in Westminster Abbey, where Britain immortalizes its great writers, poets and other famous men. Wilson said the stone will be unveiled by Queen Elizabeth at a service on Sept. 19 commemorating the Second World War aerial Battle of Britain.

The old home and tailor shop and office of Mr. and Mrs. Hume remains the same as the day they left here and their memory of this vicinity's finest family in that long ago will remain as long as any of the older class remain to recall the Hume family.
