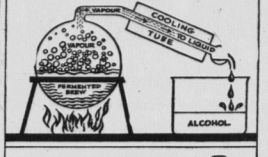

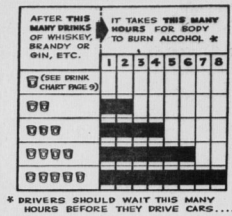


DRINK CHART

WHEN ALCOHOL IS DISTRIBUTED THROUGHOUT THE BODY THE BLOOD-STREAM, PART OF IT (ABOUT TWO PERCENT) IS ELIMINATED IN THE URINE AND THE REST MUST BE BURNED IN THE BODY LIKE FAT, SUGARS AND OTHER FOODS. ONLY THE LIVER CAN BURN ALCOHOL, AND THIS AT A FIXED RATE. THIS ALCOHOL IS PROCESSED MORE SLOWLY THAN OTHER FOODSTUFFS.
