**MONTREAL (CP)**—The Montreal Stock Exchange announced Wednesday that any action toward a merger with the Canadian and Toronto Stock Exchanges has been deferred. The announcement said a special general meeting of the Montreal Stock Exchange members decided "to conduct a study in order that the members may, at a later date, themselves decide as to the desirability of merging" the three exchanges.

"It will be appreciated, however, that this in no way implies that there will be an amalgamation."
