Opening lead—five of spades. Defense is generally passive or active in some hands, the best plan is to stand pat and do nothing that might give declarer a trick he is not entitled to. This method of play is called passive defense.

In other hands, you can't afford to sit still, but must adopt a more active form of defense. This may not appear to lead anywhere in a particular hand, but you have to attack anyhow, because you see that playing possum will allow declarer to make his contract.

Let's say you have the West hand and are defending against three trumps. You lead a spade

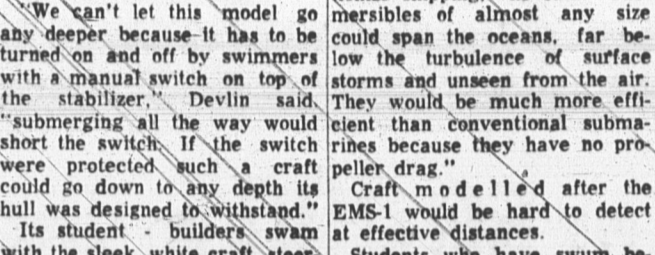
