WINNIPEG, April 17 - (CP) - Prices moved irregularly and generally lower in moderately active trade today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Trade reports said close to 2,500,000 bushels of Canadian barley had been sold for export, with Germany taking in excess of 2,000,000 bushels and the Netherlands 400,000. Other business was in the offing. The market showed hesitation, with declines coming in sympathy with United States markets. Commercial demand was limited. No information was available on export wheat loadings. Class two wheat and I.W.A. prices were down one-eighth cent. 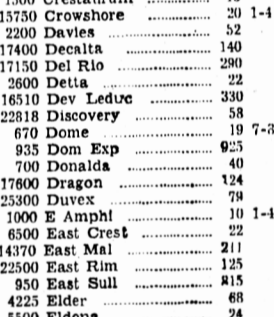
