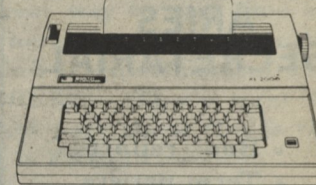

Since, as mentioned before, there is limited space in the Yearbook, all this does not guarantee publication of all photos, but an effort will be made to give equal space to all groups.
