## Ask Miners To Take Cut In Pay

MONTREAL (CP)—East Sullivan Mines Ltd. has asked miners in its copper-zinc-silver-gold mine in the Val d'Or district of Quebec to accept a 20-per-cent pay cut, the company disclosed Thursday.

This move is an attempt to avoid closing the mine in the face of depressed metal prices and operating losses, the company said.

Deadline for the union—the United Steelworkers of America—acceptance of the proposal was set for May 31.

A spokesman for the company said that if the wage cut is accepted the company will "attempt to stay in production as long as possible dependent on earnings."

If the company continued to lose money the mine would probably shut down despite the pay cut.
