

 Lunch was served by hostess and committee in charge.

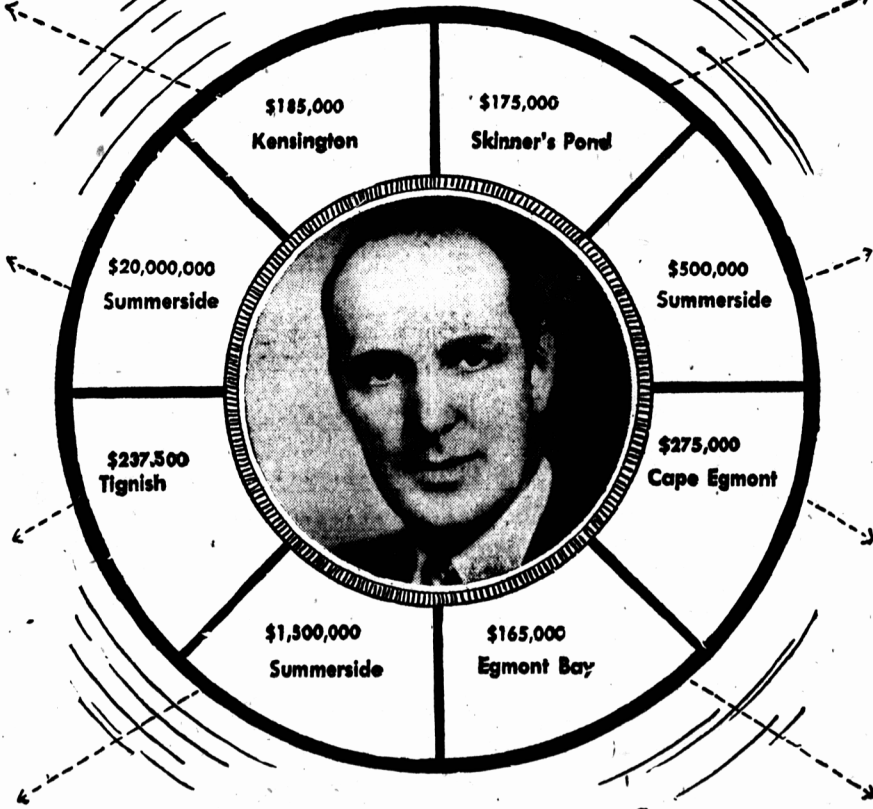
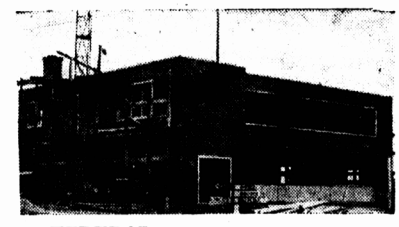
