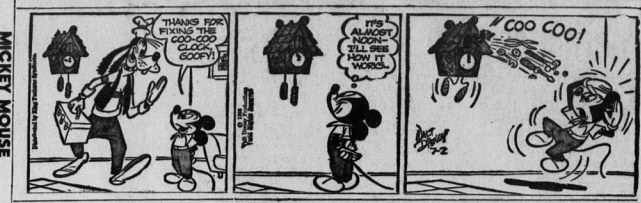

**Grain Exports Trend Changes**

OTTAWA (CP)—A sharp drop in barley exports to Communist China combined with major new sales of oats to Western Europe affected Canada's export grain picture during the first nine months of the current crop year. A bureau of statistics report Friday for the August-April period showed barley shipments to Communist China were cut to 1,063,000 bushels from 17,699,000 in the corresponding period of 1961 crop year. Total barley exports fell to 5,579,000 bushels from 20,482,000. But major new sales of oats to the Netherlands, Belgium and West Germany, coupled with increased exports to Britain and the United States, boosted oat exports to 12,977,000 bushels for the nine months from 1,218,000 a year earlier. Rice exports increased to 6,281,000 bushels from 3,364,000, and flaxseed shipments gained slightly to 9,315,000 from 9,285,000.

**OPEN GAS PLANT**  
WHITECOURT, Alta. (CP)—A \$35,000,000 natural gas processing plant was officially opened here Wednesday. Operated by Pan American Petroleum Corporation for itself and Canadian Titan Oil Ltd. and Hudson's Bay Oil and Gas Co. Ltd., the plant processes 177,000,000 cubic feet of gas daily.
