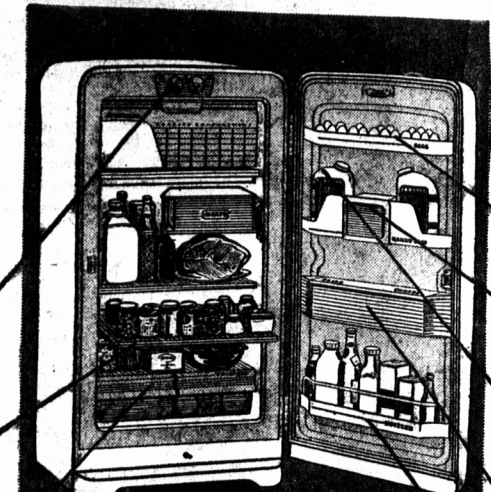

More Women in Industry

OTTAWA (CP)—Of every 1,000 persons employed by Canadian industry at Feb. 1, 229 were women, the largest February proportion since 1950.
This year's figure compares with 227 per 1,000 last year, 224 in 1953, 215 in 1952, 225 in 1951, 231 in 1950, 223 in 1949 and 226 in 1947 and 241 in 1946, the bureau of statistics reported Tuesday.
Industrial employment in Canada was 1.1 per cent below the 1954 level at the start of February. The decline was sharper for men than for women, amounting to 1.3 and .4 per cent, respectively, at the age of three.

MONTREAL, May 5th—Everybody loves Lemon Pie! So delight the whole family with this Lemon Meringue Pie—made, of course, with BENGON'S or CANADA CORN STARCH.

LEMON MERINGUE PIE
(Basic Recipe)
6 tablespoons Bengon's or Canada Corn Starch
1/4 teaspoon salt
1 cup granulated sugar
2 cups water
3 egg yolks, slightly beaten
2 tablespoons butter

MIX Bengon's or Canada Corn Starch, salt and 1 cup sugar in top of double boiler; blend well. ADD water gradually, mixing well; place over boiling water; gradually fold in 3 slightly beaten egg whites (omit extra juice and sugar). COOK into serving dish; cool well, garnish as desired. YIELD: 8 to 9 servings.

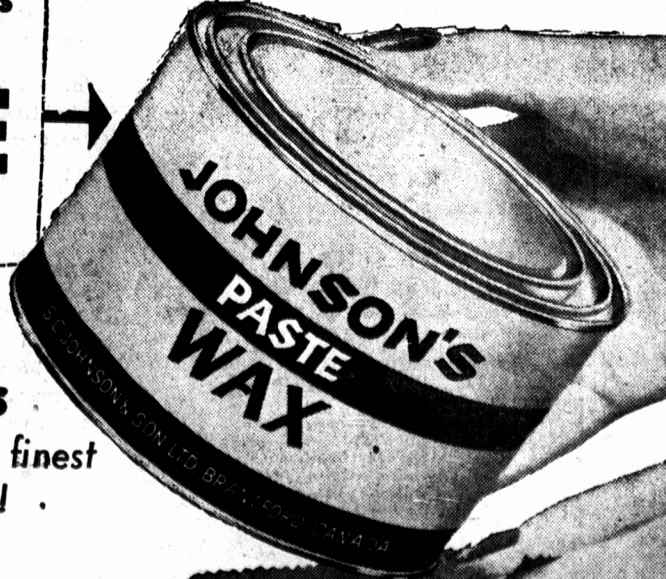
VARIATIONS USING THE BASIC RECIPE
Lemon Pudding: COMBINE and cook as directed. SUBSTITUTE 1 cup of milk and 2 cups of water for the liquid. USE 2 egg yolks. COOL pudding completely; gradually fold in 2 slightly beaten egg whites (omit extra juice and sugar). FILL into serving dish; cool well, garnish as desired. YIELD: 8 to 9 servings.
Lemon Filling for Cake: COMBINE and cook as directed. USE 1/2 the ingredients but use the full amount of lemon juice and rind. REPLACE the egg yolks with 1 whole egg. OMEP the meringue. COOL, slightly before filling cake or cup cakes. YIELD: 1/2 cups.
Lemon Sauce: COMBINE and cook as directed. USE 1/2 the sugar and 1/4 Bengon's or Canada Corn Starch; omit the egg yolks and meringue; but use the same quantities of all remaining ingredients. SERVE hot. YIELD: 2 cups sauce.
