Stock prices retreated, though moderately, on a broad front. Oils were conspicuous in their resistance to the decline. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks fell 50 cents to \$194.80.

MONTREAL (CP) — Prices were mixed in active trading Wednesday on the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges. Banks advanced, showing gains up to 2 1/2. Up a point were Nova Scotia at 67 and Banque Canadienne Nationale at 47. Banque Provinciale du Canada was up 2 1/2 at 33. Bank of Montreal advanced 2 at 52 1/2. Bank of Commerce was up 1 1/2 at 57. McColl, up 2 at 67, reached a new high in the oils. B.A. lost 1/4 at 44 and Imperial was off 1/4 at 47 1/2.

TORONTO (CP) — The stock market was mixed Wednesday as western oils maintained a one-third point index gain but base metals lost three-quarters of a point. Golds were down a few decimal points. News of favorable assay reports of recent drilling on the Canadian Malartic and Barnat properties in Quebec spurred activity. Malartic added 43 cents at \$1.96 while Barnat gained 18 cents at \$1.18. East Amphi, with properties adjoining the other companies, added 2 cents to 28 cents.

Defends Quotas On Lead, Zinc

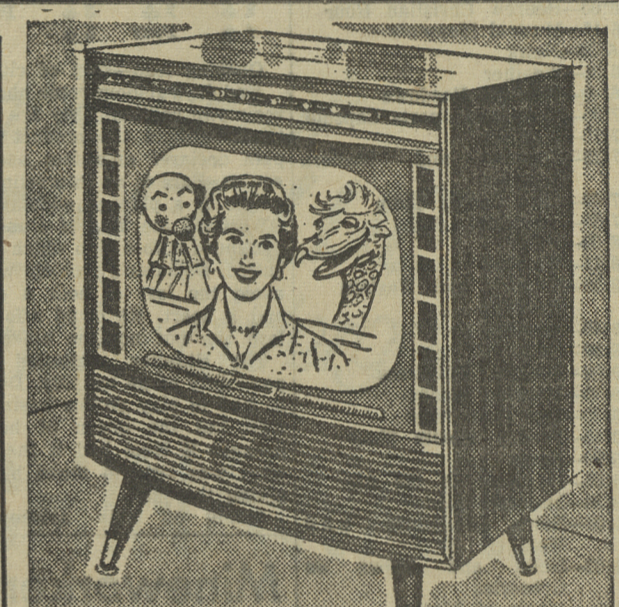
