"Blooming" Tuna Aspic Sunday Supper Feature

SUNDAY suppers were customary a generation ago, not only for family get-togethers but for special entertaining. With a turn of time's wheel, they come again, probably because a substantial Sunday Brunch is becoming a national custom. And Sunday supper, often outdoors in the summer sunset glow or moon rise is a gracious and beautiful way to end the day.

Mean Essentials
There is one "must" about Sunday suppers. The menu should consist of foods prepared a day in advance, and merely reheated, preferably at table in a chafing dish or electric tray, or "cold cooked" in the refrigerator as in the following menu:

- SUNDAY SUPPER**
Tuna Molds with Chicory Leaves
Tomato Halves with Mayonnaise Piquante
Brown 'n' Serve Rolls
Diced Mango (Fresh or Canned) and orange sections (Refrigerated)
Brown - Edge Cookies (Homemade or Purchased)
Iced Tea or Coffee Milk

- PETAL - PRETTY TUNA MOLDED IN ASPIC**
12 medium pitted ripe olives
1 can (8 1/2 or 7 oz.) tuna in-vegetable oil,
flaked corase
1 envelope unflavored gelatin
1 c. cold water
1 can (10 1/2 oz.) condensed beef consommé
1/4 tsp. Tabasco
3 tbsp. lemon juice
1 1/4 c. diced celery
1/4 c. fine-chopped green pepper
Chicory leaves

Cut ripe olives in thin slices, then in halves. Place 6 of the slices in bottom of each of 6 (5 1/4 or custard cups (or 5 c. mold) to form a ring. Center a piece of tuna in olive ring.
Add gelatin to cold water and let stand 5 min. Place over low heat; stir until dissolved. Remove from heat. Add consommé, Tabasco and lemon juice. Spoon 1 tsp. of mixture over olive and tuna in each of the molds; refrigerate. Also refrigerate the remaining gelatin mixture over olive and tuna in mixture until it is the consistency of unbeaten egg white; fold in remaining tuna, celery a green pepper. Spoon into molds. Refrigerate 4 hrs. more or until firm enough to unmold. Garnish with chicory leaves. Accompany with seasoned tomato, topped with chopped hard-cooked egg and diced cucumber. Pass Mayonnaise Piquante (often columned).
