MILWAUKEE (AP)—A young Lutheran minister accused of heresy by his synod was found guilty Thursday night on nine counts of deviating from church doctrine.

Findings, against Rev. George P. Crist Jr., 31, were returned by the trial board of the Northwest synod, United Lutheran Church after three hours of deliberation.

Pastor Crist was summoned from his home and church at Durham in nearby Waukesha county to hear the verdict.
