## Plante Signs A Record Contract With Rangers

NEW YORK (AP)—Jacques Plante breezed into town from Montreal Monday, promptly signed a contract making him the highest paid goalie in Ranger history, and gave New York's hockey buffs something to talk about besides the heat.

Salary terms for the six-time Vezina Trophy winner were not disclosed, but were estimated at \$22,000.

The 33-year-old French-Canadian, never one to hesitate in his own achievements, oozed confidence at a press conference. He was acquired from Montreal Canadiens in a seven-player trade last month.

The Rangers are on the way up and the Canadiens are on their way down, so I'm happy to be in New York," Plante said. Then, referring to Gump Worsley, the little net minder who moved to the Canadiens in the same deal, he said "Gump is a nice guy and a friend of mine. But he's where he belongs... with a team that is not going to be and they still expected us to finish in first place. I feared going up and talking salary with them. With Muzz (Ranger General Manager Muzz Patrick) it took

five minutes and I was signed. I'm getting the salary I should have been paid by Montreal years ago.

The Rangers, who finished fifth last season, two notches below the Canadiens, now have five players from Montreal's outstanding clubs of the late 1950's. The others are defencemen Doug Harvey and Al Lange-

lois and forwards Phil Goyette and Don Marshall. The latter two were included in last month's mammoth transaction. Harvey, 38, is a nine-time all-star.
