New Series Of Satellites Will Probe Earth's Shape

By HOWARD BENEDICT CAPE KENNEDY, Fla. (AP) - Man-made satellites are revealing secrets about mother earth that most women prefer to keep confidential. But the trust is that our planet has more dips and bulges and a heftier waistline than a circus fat lady. And the U.S. national geospatial and space administration is about to launch the first of a new series of satellites, which will tell even more about her not-so-curved surface. A geodesic explorer named Geos 1 is to be launched from Cape Kennedy Wednesday. It is equipped with flashing lights, laser beam reflectors and other equipment designed to give geodesicists the best information yet on the shape of the earth and distances between far-apart places. It is hoped Geos 1 and its successors will help pinpoint distances between ocean-separated cities to within 35 feet. Presently, distances between cities on continuous well-mapped land masses such as New York City and Moscow are known only to within 500 to 1,000 feet. The exact location of some remote islands is off as much as 10 miles. EARTH NOT ROUND The value of satellites as map-makers was discovered in 1959 when the second U.S. satellite, the grapefruit-sized Vanguard-1, showed that the earth was not round but slightly pear-shaped. This was learned when tracking showed Vanguard 1 was circling the globe on a course that was not quite smooth. Closest analysis showed the sea level at the North Pole was about 50 feet higher than was considered normal for a perfectly round earth. At the South Pole, the sea level was lower by about the same margin. Moreover, the bulge below the equator was about 50 feet greater than a bulge above it. The defence department realized that targeting information for intercontinental range missiles might be hundreds of feet off and developed a series of satellites to help map the earth. This included the Anna and Secor geodesic satellites and the transit navigation satellites. These payloads helped refine measurements and found that the earth has four corners and five troughs or depressions. Each of the corners covers several thousand square miles, with a maximum distance of up to 450 feet between the high and low points. The high points are located near Okinawa, just west of Peru in the Pacific, east of Iceland in the North Atlantic and midway between Africa and Australia in the South Indian Ocean. The lows, or depressions, are in the Antarctic, the Indian Ocean south of India, just off Charleston, S.C., midway between California and Hawaii and just south of the Aleutian chain in the North Pacific. The satellite is studded with 322 prisms to reflect the beams of a laser, an electronic device that generates an extremely narrow shaft of light and retains its intensity over long distances. The time required for the light to shoot up to Geos 1 and return to earth will determine the satellite's position and thus aid in interpretation of geodesic information obtained from its lights and radio signals.

Construction Firm Bidding Limited To Better Contracts

By KEN EMMOND WINNIPEG (CP) - Management reorganization in the construction division of British-American Construction and Materials Ltd. has resulted in reorganized sales but increased earnings for the company. Construction subdivisions have each been allocated specific equipment and a built-in profit objective. Careful selection of construction bids has been a natural outgrowth of the new system. "We just don't jump at every job that comes along," said President Saul Simkin. The firm's semi-annual report showed a 16-per-cent dip in construction sales compared with the first six months of 1964 but net income increased 38 per cent to \$590,000. Ross Turner, company treasurer, said the reorganization was part of a plan geared toward "maximum utilization of fixed assets of the company in equipment, manpower and resources."

Actress' Death Report Given

LOS ANGELES (AP) - Actress Marie McDonald's death was caused by a mixture of drugs and could have been accidental or suicidal, the coroner's office said. Miss McDonald was found dead in her home Oct. 21 and the cause was not immediately determined. Dr. Kenneth Chapman, chief autopsy surgeon, said tests indicate death was due to "active drug intoxication due to multiple drugs."
