Also, grad rings will be ordered at the end of September so watch for announcements regarding the exact dates and times.

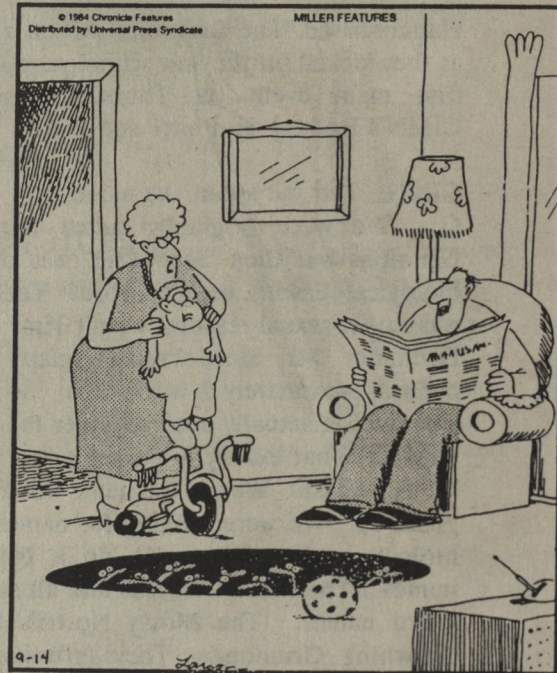
