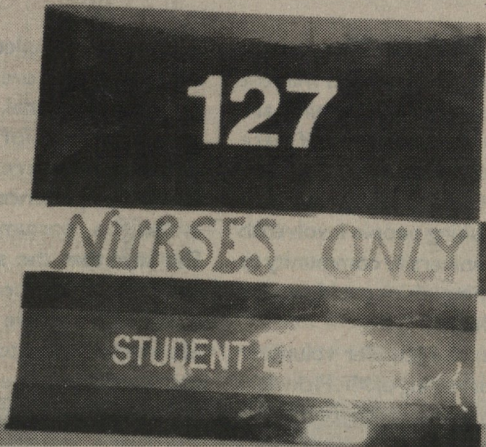


Lounge Lizards

This week we are looking at the lounges in the Steele building and Dalton Hall.



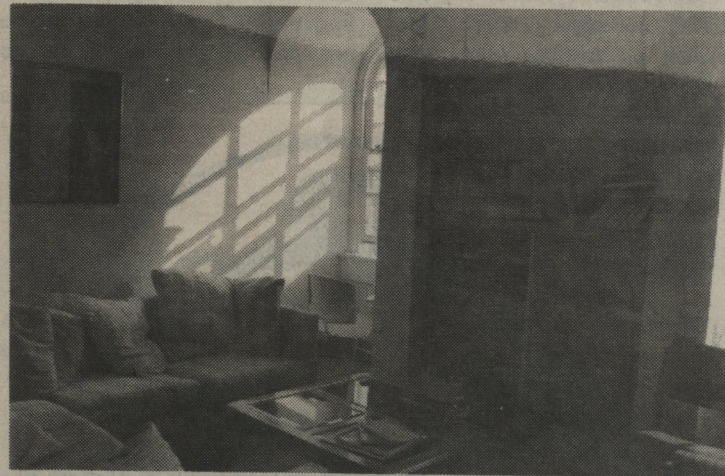
The nurses lounge looked rather formidable so we didn't dare go inside.



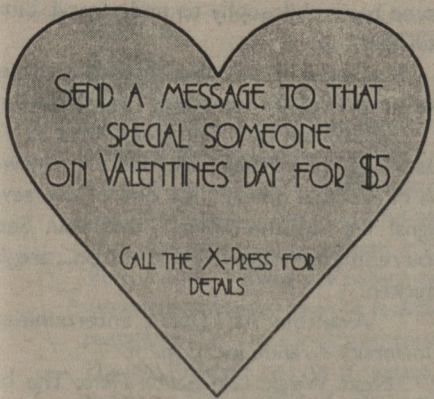
