My brother Brendon was home for a month, he worked most of the last summer with Clint Hodgins and then joined the Sanders Russell outfit. He went back to New Egypt to work for the Stanley Dancer string. He had a good season, saw lots of racing and saw quite a bit of the country. He was at Roosevelt, then on to Yonkers and when the racing season ended he attended the Harrisburg sale, the Delaware sale and the Lexington sale. He was with Don Larlee for a while at Lexington.

"Don had a string for a Quebec party, but I saw in the Harpers Horse where they had sold from Brendon was over to Sara-aga and Freehold, also to Gosh- for the Hamiltonian. Red MacPherson is back with the O'Brien outfit, he was with Angie Allen. Lofty Bruce from Truro is with Harry Fitzpatrick and Russell White from the Island is with Curley Smart at Delaware. Jack Quinn is also doing well in the big time. Joe MacDonald from Mahon, C.B. is working for Del Miller and Wendy Carroll are with Earle Avery. Lee Campbell from Sydney was with Bob Ryan, so there are lots of Nova Scotia and Islanders in the States with the horses.

**YOUNG WINNER**  
Well, I said I was going to write about the Cape Breton race scene so I had better leave the two-minute ones and drop a few seconds slower. Henry O'Donnell was in town recently and he is going to take over the Jabalee stable of Handbook 203 2-5, Volon 2, 111 2-5, Grand Miss Volo, a 3-year-old by High Volo, Miss Hazel Hal, Arabian Night 2, 2-20 2-5 and Wilkin 2.08. The last race of the season at Sydney Arabian Night, driven by young Adam Lewis, Worrell's son, and Wilkin, driven by Worrell, won their respective races so Worrell and the old Wilkin were pretty proud poppas. Adam is just a teenager but he shows his way around the race track. He drove quite a bit last summer.

"Cape Breton also had another young driver that shows great promise. He is Donnie Coady of Sydney. Donnie drove for the Donald Rankin stable and he gave Celia Sharon a new mark of 2:13 4-5. He tied Neil Kalmuck's record for fastest Maritime bred trotting mare in 1956. Donnie was just breeding with Celia by a nostril in 2:12 3-5 by David Caudle, so Donnie can get the most out of them. I'm sure that if these boys get a chance to do a lot of driving this summer they will certainly show that they have the know how.

**WINTER JOGGING**  
Most of the horsemen are jogging every day. Mike Jabalee has two sons, Joe Hood has three including Dan Budnick that he reared so well last season, the Reid's horse, Colonel Hansford and Billy Lee Direct, a horse that came down from Chris O'Donnell's. Worrell Lewis, Greg MacDonald, the Donald Rankin stable, are all jogging regularly. Harold Hunt, the only horseman in Cape Breton wearing a beard, is going daily with Stan Cleary's Voltador 2:13 2-5. It is interesting to hear some horsemen say that jogging in the winter is not too essential, but I think that the ones that are well legged up in the winter and training slow miles in the spring are the ones earning the most money when the checks are tallied in the fall.

"You will see an article on Collie Breking by Del Miller in the last issue of Hoof Beats, that a lot of these colts are bought at Harrisburg sale in November, are harnessed broken and start jogging in December and in January they are working miles. This training goes on and on until they start to race in June, or course down in Florida and the warmer parts of the States they have the weather conditions to train under. I hope that this year Cape Breton will have a good racing season. Jimmie Ferguson puts a lot of time and effort to keep the game alive, here's hoping that the Ted Gibbons of Cape Breton comes up with a good season of racing under the stars at the Cape Breton Sports Club."
