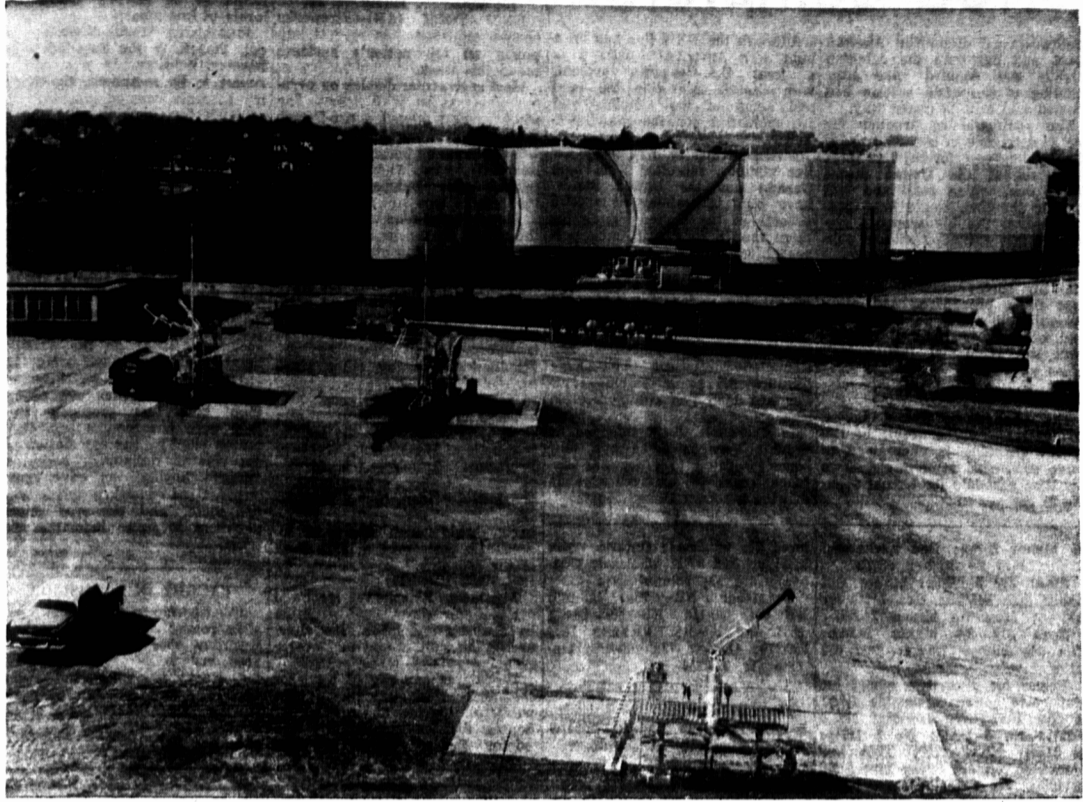


OPENING TODAY IMPERIAL OIL MARINE TERMINAL



IMPERIAL OIL MARINE TERMINAL

A \$1,000,000 marine terminal designed to improve oil distribution facilities on Prince Edward Island will be opened in Charlottetown today by Imperial Oil.

The new terminal is part of a program designed to meet the Islands' increased petroleum needs. As well as the new marine facilities, improvements costing \$200,000 have been made in bulk plants in outlying districts such as Summerside, Albany, Alberton, Montague, Morell, Murray Harbour, O'Leary and Souris.

FOUR MILES PIPE

Four miles of pipe lines have been laid over the 3,000 foot distance between the Charlottetown government docks and the terminal's six storage tanks. These lines will receive oil products brought in by tanker from Imperial's Halifax refinery.

The steel tanks have a total capacity of 262,000 barrels or 9,170,000 Imperial gallons. The largest

tank holds 67,000 barrels of bunker fuel. Two 54,000-barrel tanks contain gasoline and furnace oil. Two 30,000-barrel tanks hold gasoline and stove oil and a sixth will contain 24,000 barrels of diesel oil. Eight small tanks with a total capacity of 3,000 barrels will be used for storing miscellaneous oil products.

FUTURE EXPANSION

A brick office, a boiler house, a warehouse and high-speed equipment for loading and unloading tank trucks and tank cars are spread over the 15-acre area on Grafton Street near the Hillsboro Bridge. Plans allow for future expansion when necessary.

A vapor dome conservation system mounted over one tank and connected by pipe with the other tanks will minimize product losses by evaporation. The tanks are painted in pastel colors.

The major contractors who handled the construction were County Const. Co., Island Construction Ltd., Chappell and Co., Warren Paving Co., Matheson and MacMillan Ltd., and Douglas Bros. and Jones. The tanks were erected by Horton Steel Works.

Study Pictou For Minerals

HALIFAX (CP)—Mines Minister Jamnann announced Thursday Noranda Exploration Company has started explorations in a 35-square-mile area of the Blue Mountain district of Pictou County. The exploration may include diamond drilling.

He said the Teck Hughes Exploration Company of Kirkland Lake, Ont., has taken over a 30-square-mile tract of land adjoining the Noranda concession and exploration will begin sometime next week.

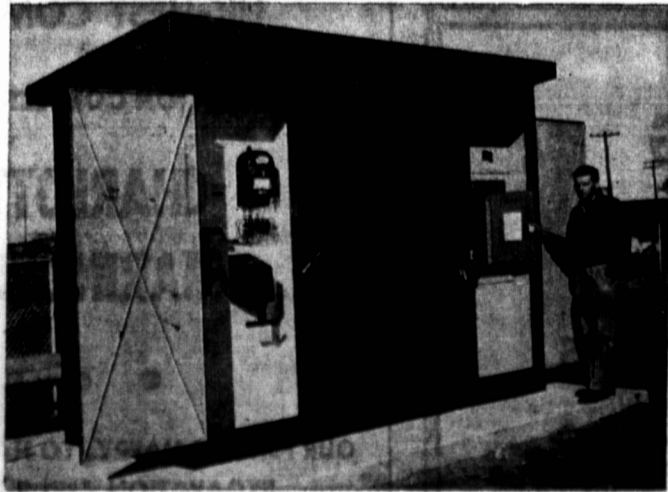
Allstate Uranium Corporation which has claims in the Blind River area of Ontario, will investigate a section of Antigonish County in August, the announcement said.
