

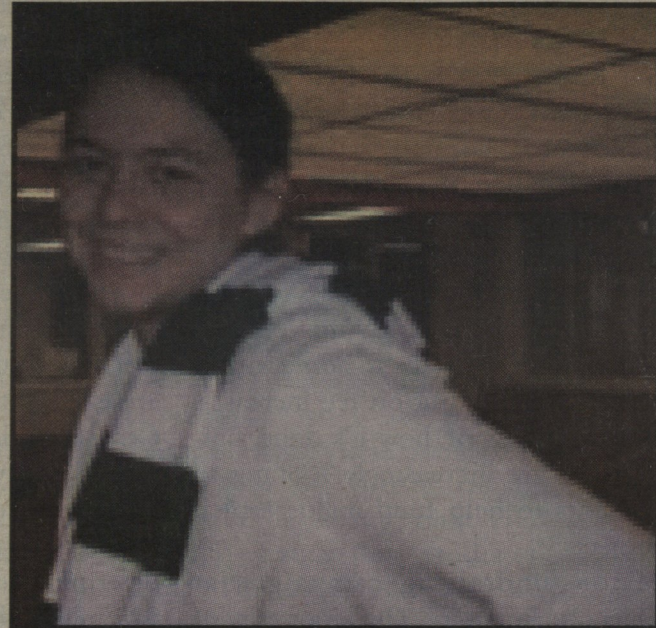
# How Do You Feel About the Possibility of a Strike?

I'd prefer it to be on Monday because I have a test



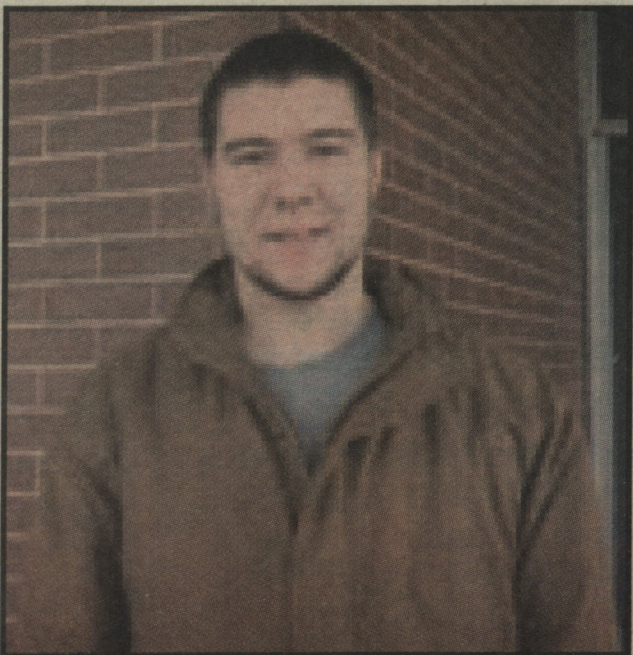
**Peng Gao - 2<sup>nd</sup> year business**
