phosphoric acid as compared with a loss of one-fifth of its nitrogen and practically no phosphoric acid and potash when a similar lot was stored for the same time in a closed shed.

Practically every mail at this season of the year brings us enquiries from parties who would like to purchase day old chicks but who are persuaded against doing so by friends who, tell them that the chicks never thrive nor come to anything due to the hardships of the trip from the place they are hatched in their future home, adding that the day old chick trade is a new fad which is being exploited at the expense of the unweary who find it difficult to raise their own chicks at home.

This is as far from the truth and so misleading that I would like to take a little space here to show that the day old chick trade is not a new one, and that there is nothing in the business when properly handled to defeat this purpose, namely providing parties within a certain radius with good pure bred chicks which live and thrive.

In view of the fact that this trade has been known and practiced in Egypt for more than a thousand years certainly makes it out of the experimental class, in fact it was the only way they knew of raising chickens and when one of the large hatcheries there hatched out the surrounding villages and thirty or forty little chicks were sold within twenty four hours or before they were fed, as this business is still being carried on in perhaps a more up to date manner it must be very practical.

For about twenty four hours after the chick is hatched out it is the only thing that really bothers it is sleep and more of it and it is during this time of rest and sleep that the little fellows are packed in properly constructed boxes and taken off on their journey, if that journey is not greater than thirty six hours, there is no reason why the fire world why they cannot make it comfortably in their carrier where all is dark and where conditions for sleep are ideal, as they would be in a crowded overhatched brooder, the stronger and more active ones of the hatch walking over them as if so often the case, when they are off the hatching business and as soon as the box is opened they are up and taking notice and beginning to clamour for food and water.

Chicks of low vitality from weak parents will not stand the trip well as they are of little use anyway it is just as well that this should be because the purchaser can rest assured that when his shipment arrives and the little fellows are well and lively the chances are they come from good hatching stock and the brooder who cannot land his shipments at destination in good condition is not liable to remain in the business long.

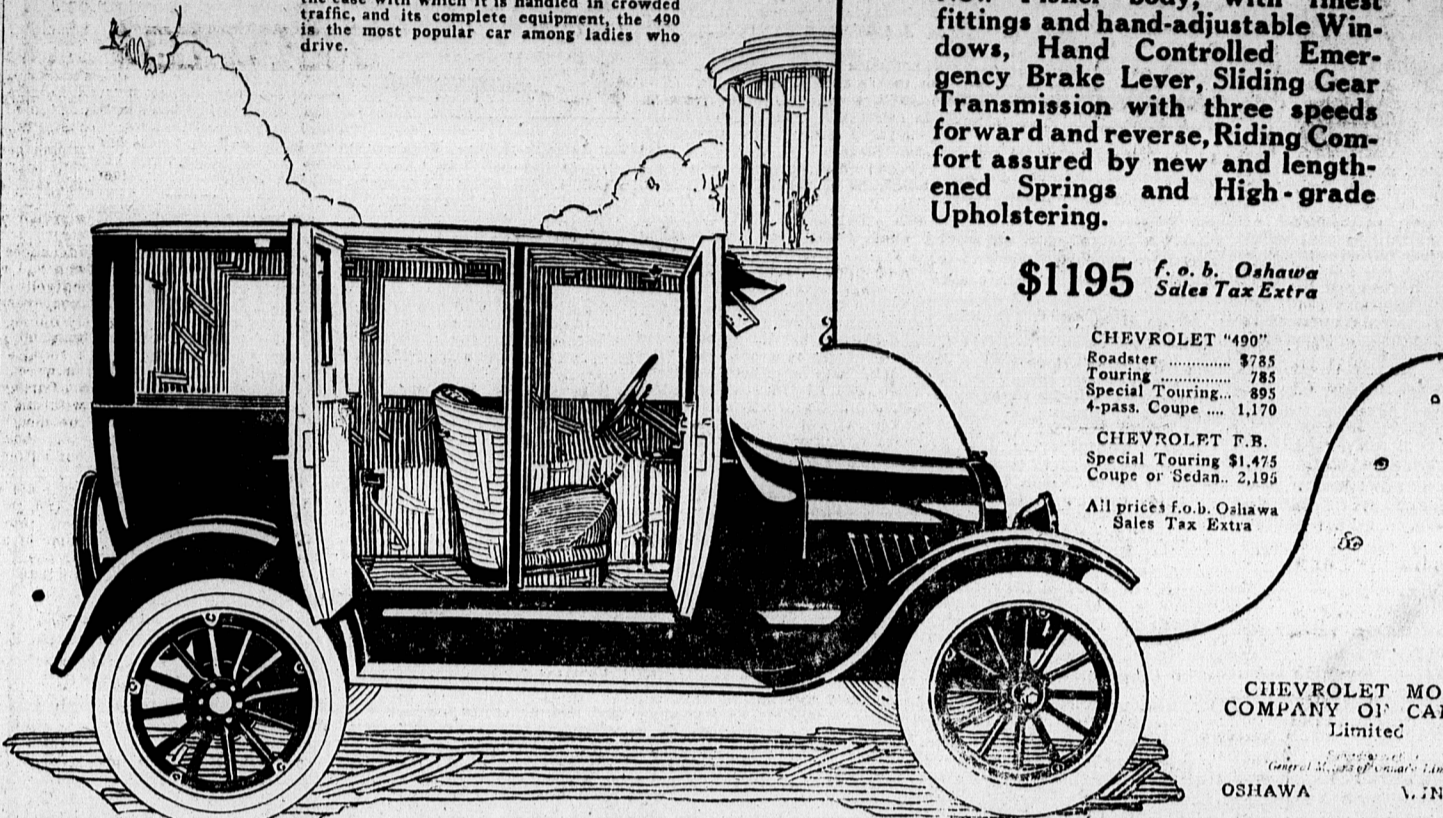

and impair action. If long continued, such detrimental influences may deal to permanent unsoundness, and they always lessen efficiency and shorten the period of utility.

To retain hoof moisture nature coats the horny walls with a cortical layer or varnish secreted by the coronary band at the hoof-sock from which the horn tubes or fibres of the wall grow downward. When the varnish is rasped off, evaporation of moisture occurs, just as an apple starts deteriorating when the peel is removed. Contraction due to such injurious rasping progresses apace, when, at the same time, the sole is pared thin, the frogs trimmed until new, soft horn is exposed and the bars are cut away and the heels "opened." It occurs the faster and surer when the horse is made to stand on a dry board floor. The effect of feces and urine at the time time is to soften, rot and disintegrate the sole and frog, or cause destructive "thrush." Canker of the frog and sole may also occur and prove almost incurable. To prevent these conditions rasping the wall of the hoof should be avoided other than to allow the formation of a bed for the clenching of nails; only those portions of the sole and frog which are already loosened and dead should be cut away, and the bare left intact and no opening of the heels allowed. Shoes should then be reset once a month, and stall floors kept clean and well-bedded. A run bare-foot on moist pasture in summer when possible also tends to maintain or restore natural conditions of hoof health.
