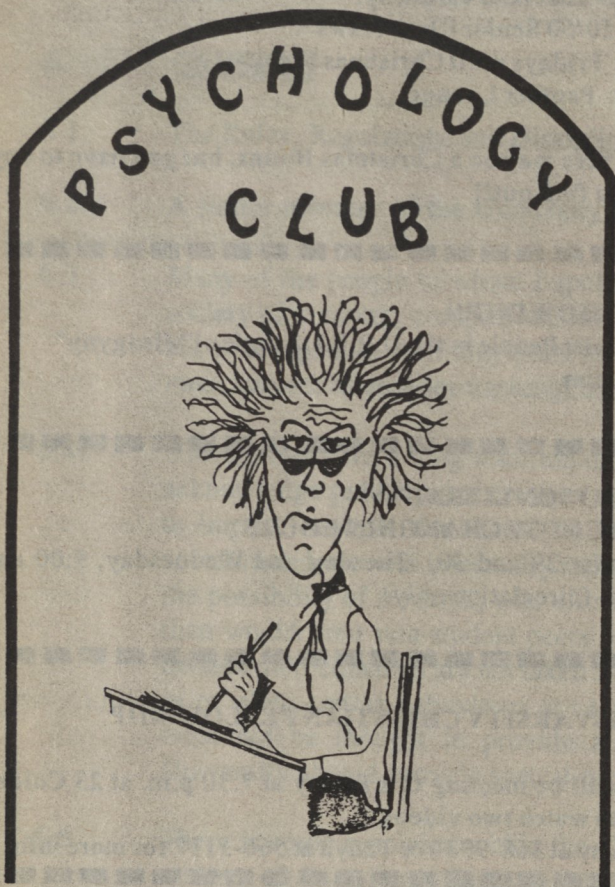
We are getting children's sizes too!
