

Australia Ready For Development

MONTREAL (CP)—Sir Douglas Slogland, Australian high commissioner to Canada, said today Australia has come of age and is ready to walk the path of economic expansion with Canada.

Speaking at a luncheon on the chemical engineering conference of the Chemical Institute of Canada, Sir Douglas said Australia now is ready to accept increasing responsibilities, "not only for her

own development, but for the maintenance of the Commonwealth of nations as a vigour force in the world."

The Australian economy had been expanding at as high a rate as any western country barring Canada.

Between 1947 and 1952 the population had increased by 1,820,000—an expansion of 15.5 per cent—and the country faced a major task in absorbing these "new Australians" without impairing living standards.

To meet this challenge Australia had added to its capital equipment

and more than one quarter of the country's production was being plowed back for capital expansion maintenance.

AMBASSADOR LEAVING

OTTAWA, (CP)—Sadao Iguchi will leave here today to take up his new post as Japanese ambassador to the United States. He will be succeeded by ambassador to Canada by Kotoo Matsudaira, who is expected to arrive here about March 25. Mr. Iguchi, Japan's first ambassador to Canada, has served in Ottawa since June, 1952.

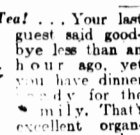

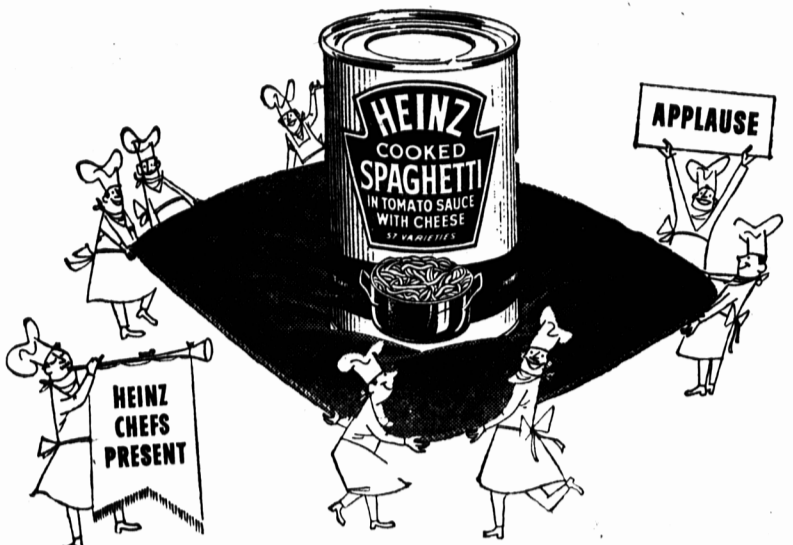

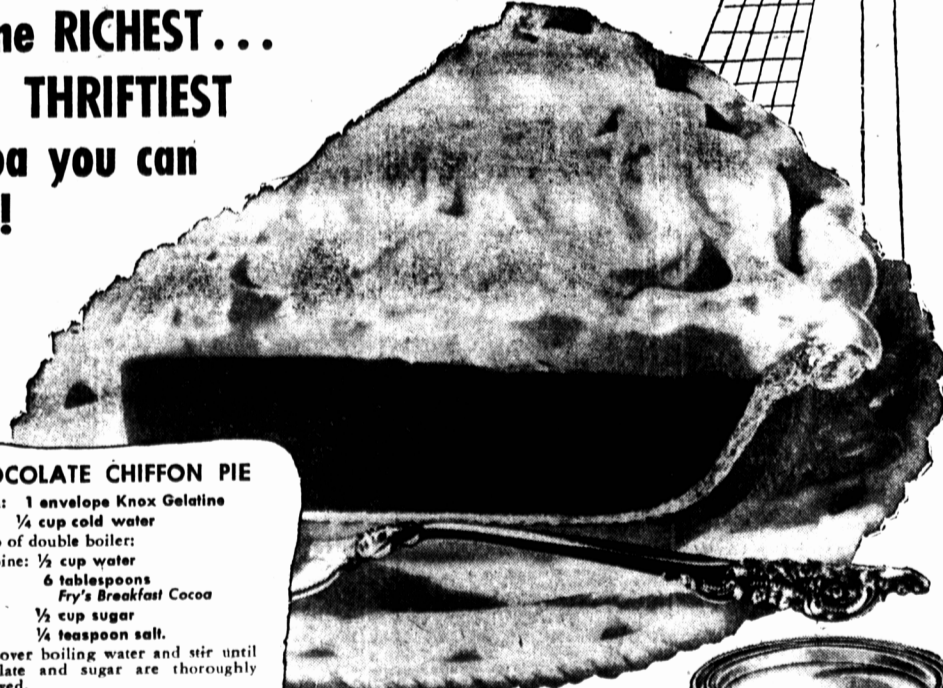

CHOCOLATE CHIFFON PIE

Softens: 1 envelope Knox Gelatine in 1/4 cup cold water
In top of double boiler: 1/2 cup water
Combine: 1/2 cup water, 6 tablespoons Fry's Breakfast Cocoa, 1/2 cup sugar, 1/4 teaspoon salt.

Beat slightly: 3 egg yolks.

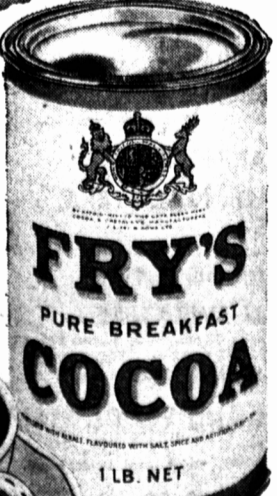

Beat until stiff: 3 egg whites
Beat in gradually: 1/2 cup sugar
Fold gelatine mixture into egg whites. Pour into baked pastry shell or Graham cracker crust. Chill until firm. If desired, garnish with whipped cream and shaved chocolate.

Corporal Johnston explained that "Northwest Passage" was a documentary film of the first crossing of the Canadian north from west to east by any ship. The hazardous trip took the R. C. M. P.'s "St. Roch" 28 months from Vancouver to Lunenburg.

In answer to questions the speaker described the use of photography in the service today, the order of rank in the service and the good relations between Mounties and young people of this Province, giving credit to the schools for their help in this respect.
