

### Course In Milk Sanitation Outlined By Dept. Of Health

Dr. Hubert McNeill, minister of health, announced yesterday that his department has completed the outline of a milk sanitation course for the staffs of pasteurizing plants in the province.

He said the proposed course will be discussed with officials of the provincial vocational school and the Fluid Milk Producers Association so that a firm course may be arranged in the near future.

Main subjects to be covered by the course are milk legislation and regulations, milk at the farm, milk plant, equipment and plant sanitation.

Dr. McNeill explained that

public is receiving a safe supply of pasteurized milk.

"My department is prepared, as always," he said, "to offer whatever help it can, to the producers and the pasteurizing plants, in the way of advice, consultation and education, as well as inspection and testing."

### P.E.I. Loans Are Granted

OTTAWA — There were 56 National Housing Act loans for single family dwellings approved for Prince Edward Island in

1961. It was revealed here this week in a return tabled in the House of Commons. The 56 P.E.I. loans involved \$668,000, only the Yukon and Northwest Territories had fewer loans during the year. Newfoundland had 274, Nova Scotia 890 and New Brunswick 724. Largest number were in Ontario with 15,460.

### BIG ONION CARGO

BRISTOL, England (CP) — Canada's largest shipment of onions to Britain has been landed here. Nearly 300 tons were unloaded from the cargo liner Calgeria sailing from Montreal. Canada has exported more than 3,000 tons of onions to Britain this year.


