A suggestion that compulsory inspection of table stock potatoes be discontinued in favour of central packing by experienced graders was made yesterday by Mr. Paul Clement, Supervisor Consolidated Retail Services, Ottawa.

He said that under the compulsory inspection system there is always the tendency to grade and pack with the idea of just getting by the inspector. This suggests that something new must be tried... something that places the responsibility where it belongs, on the shoulders of the growers, packers, shippers, wholesalers and even retailers to deliver to the consumer the quality she wants in the size and style of package that fully meets her demands.

ANCIENT CANOE

This water-worn hull may be the remains of a canoe fashioned by Indians 5,000 years ago. It was found in Haines Lake by Norman Ritchie of Richmond Hill, Ont., when he was skin diving. Examined by Dr. Norman Emerson, University of Toronto archaeologist, the hull was pronounced the work of prehistoric Indians since all tribes of the area at the coming of white men built their canoes of birch bark.
