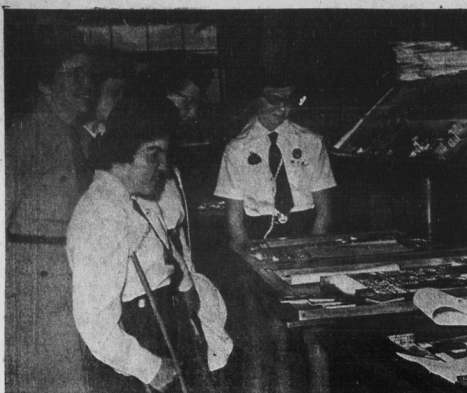
## Murray R. To Join RHS

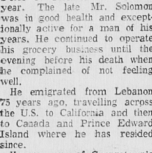
GEORGETOWN — The death occurred at his home in Georgetown, Wednesday, June 5 of Peter J. Solomon in his 88th year. The late Mr. Solomon was in good health and exceptionally active for a man of his years. He continued to operate his grocery business until the evening before his death when he complained of not feeling well.

He emigrated from Lebanon 73 years ago, travelling across the U.S. to California and then to Canada and Prince Edward Island where he has resided since. He was one of Georgetown's most highly regarded citizens. Many years ago he opened a grocery business which he successfully operated until the time of his death. He was a former town councillor, and a former member of the Georgetown school board.

He was married in 1906 to the former Mary Balthazard of Georgetown who predeceased him in 1950. A son Gerald predeceased him in 1951. He is survived by one son Raymond of Georgetown and three daughters, Sister M. Carmelita, CSM of Kingston, Ont.; (Helen) Mrs. Vincent Elordette of Montreal, and Genevieve of
