Financial Britain Follows Canadian Economic Progress

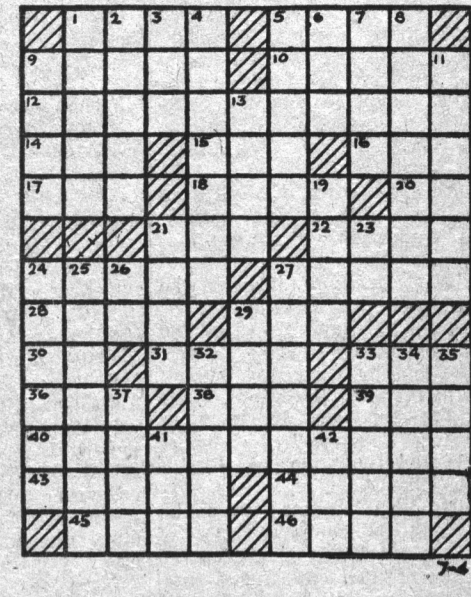

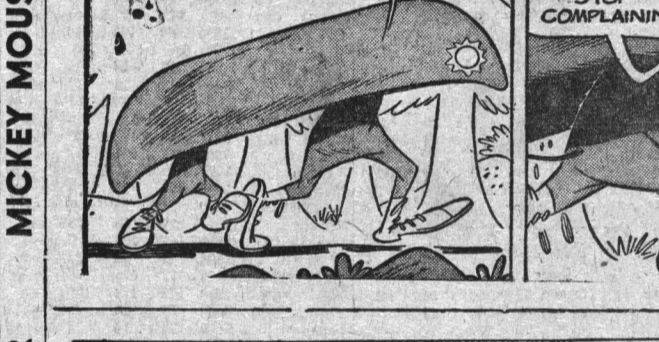
