

### De Gaulle, Erhard End Conferences

 BONN (AP) — Front de Gaulle of France and Chancellor Erhard of West Germany wound up two days of conferences here by agreeing to make new efforts toward European political unity. But their ideas on how this should be achieved remained far apart.

In an unscheduled, hour-long private meeting, Erhard promised the visiting French leader to put forth some West German proposals for promoting European unity. The assurances seemed largely designed to smooth over what one high-ranking German source termed clearly different views of Europe's future.

### New Fisheries Vessel Ordered

OTTAWA (CP) — A 130-foot fisheries research vessel equipped with the latest navigation and electronic gear is being ordered by the Fisheries Research Board for its Atlantic fleet, it was announced here.

Tenders have been called for the vessel, which is scheduled to go into service in the spring of 1968. It will have a range of 3,000 miles at a cruising speed of 11 knots and will be equipped for stern trawling and scallop dragging.

The vessel will have a complement of 21 scientific officials and crew.

### Canada, U.S. Split Dory Races

GLoucester, Mass. (AP)—Canada's two-man senior double dory crew won the summer regatta of the annual Lunenburg Cup competition here.

The Canadian entry from Lunenburg, N.S., posted a six-length victory over the one-mile course at Gloucester's Inner Harbor. The American entry in the senior men's event was from Gloucester.

An American boat from Marblehead won the junior men's race while a crew from Rockport, Mass., captured the girls' competition.

The traditional rivalry will be renewed in Lunenburg in September.

### Record Is Set At U.S. Wedding

ST. LOUIS (AP) — Mr. and Mrs. Patrick C. Barker were married recently in what is believed to be the first U.S. wedding officiated jointly by Roman Catholic and Protestant clergy.

A Roman Catholic priest, Rev. Leonard Jackson, and an Episcopal (Anglican) priest, Rev. Claudius Miller, married the couple June 13 in a suburban Watson Woods Roman Catholic Church. Each priest read the vows from the Episcopal Book of Common Prayer.

Father Jackson used the exhortation and final blessing from the Roman Catholic clergy.

Barker, of St. Louis, the groom, is a Roman Catholic. His new wife, the former Susan Ekberg of Greenwich, Conn., is Episcopalian. The combined ceremony was arranged by Joseph Cardinal Ritter, archbishop of the St. Louis Roman Catholic diocese, and Bishop George L. Cadigan of the Episcopal diocese of Missouri. The bride's parents requested the ceremony.

The wedding was not announced until Friday because the bride and bridegroom wished to avoid publicity before their honeymoon.

A Roman Catholic spokesman explained that Roman Catholics and Episcopalians "are not far apart in rituals and ceremonies."

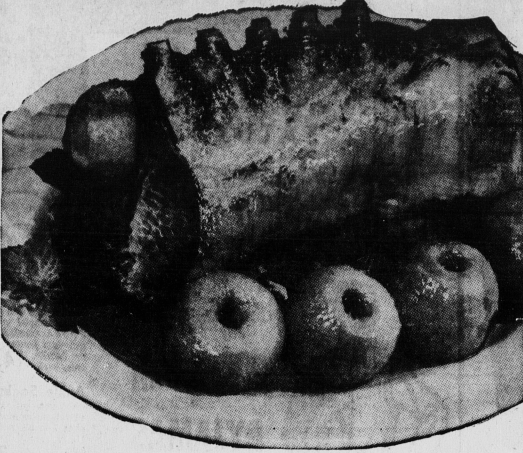

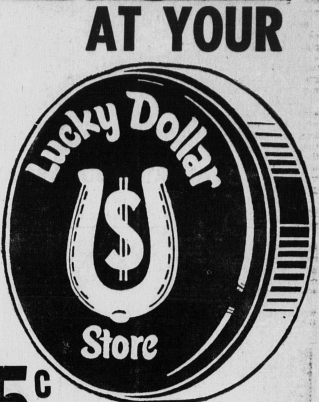
