Solicitor-General Fitzpatrick to Return to the Holy See.

Archbishop Begin, Too, On the Way.

QUEBEC, March 3.

Archbishop Begin has left for Rome, and Solicitor-General Fitzpatrick leaves for the same city some time this week.

A letter received yesterday from the Canadian College at Rome says that the Pope talked to Hon. Mr. Fitzpatrick for over an hour, that the Solicitor-General admitted that the school settlement was unsatisfactory and said that he would improve it in time.

His Holiness asked why, if the Liberal party was well disposed, they did not grant justice to the minority? Fitzpatrick finally asked for a papal ablegate or commissioner, and the Pope replied that the Vatican would consult with the Canadian Bishops, in whom he had every confidence.
