THE PROVINCIAL ACCOUNTS.

ACCORDING TO THE PROVINCIAL AUDITOR'S REPORT, THE DEFICIT OF LAST YEAR WAS \$20,164.21.

At the end of last year, the balance against the Province was stated as follows: Treasury Balance, \$163,377.91; Stock Farm Balance, \$6,225.65; Total, \$169,603.56.

At the end of 1894, the balance is thus stated: Treasury Balance, \$117,742.62; Stock Farm Balance, \$7,305.88; Total, \$125,048.50.

In view of a deficit of \$20,164.21, and an addition of upwards of a thousand dollars to the debt of the Stock Farm, the reduction of the balance against the Province from \$169,603.56 to \$125,048.50 is a little peculiar.

It is evident either that the Treasury balance is deceptive, or that we have at the head of affairs a genius who accomplishes feats in finance not unworthy a hero of the Arabian Nights Entertainments.

The latter amount is simply placed against the expenditures and subtracted from the balance of last year. In this way it appears that, instead of the balance against the Province being swelled at the end of 1894 by the amount of the deficit, there has been a considerable reduction of that balance.

The interest account plays no pranks. Instead of \$10,197.37, as in 1893, it is shown that there was paid an interest on the provincial debt in 1894 the sum of \$14,813.74.

THE COMPANIES' INCORPORATION ACT. The spirit in which our Legislature began work on Monday was admirable.

Notary Public, a Commissioner for taking affidavits in the Supreme or County Courts, or a Justice of the Peace, a certificate in duplicate, setting forth such details, the name of the proposed association, the amount of the proposed capital stock, the number of trustees who shall manage its affairs, the proposed by-laws, etc.

These are the leading features of the bill, which is designed to avoid the necessity of applying to the Legislature for a separate act of incorporation for each dairy company.
