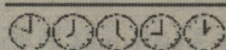

Now in its tenth year, the program has grown consistently in popularity year over year; over 500 students from across the country participated in the 2003 program.

All entries are judged on the merit of innovative and workable solutions along with a demonstration of commitment to community and leadership abilities. From the entries, 50 semi-finalists are chosen and invited to present their essays before an independent adjudication panel. From the 50, 10 finalists and an overall national winner are selected based upon their ability to express new, solution-driven ideas.

All winning student essays are published in a special book entitled @stake "As Prime Minister, I Would..."

The Magna for Canada Scholarship Fund was founded in 1995 by Magna International Inc.. Its founders, Frank and Belinda Stronach established the program to empower students to express their solutions for building a better Canada. \$1,000,000 has been placed in a charitable trust on behalf of the scholarship fund. The program is also sponsored by The Fair Enterprise Institute, a non-partisan and non-profit organization founded to provoke dialogue and debate and propose innovative solutions to improve the living standards of Canadians.
