TORONTO (CP) — Announcement of a further copper price increase by Anaconda, major United States producer, sparked a buying spree in copper on the Toronto stock market Thursday that sent a number of key issues shooting to new highs. The base metal index was at 61.66, a new peak with a jump of almost six points. Volume was a moderate 4,906,000 shares.

International Nickel led senior copper up with a gain of 4 1/2 to 85 1/2 after touching a high of 85 1/2. Noranda jumped 3 1/2 to a new peak of 62. Hudson Bay was up 2 1/2. Quemont added 1 1/2 and Consolidated Smelting and Gaspe Copper were each a point better.
