

Commission Finds Profit Unlawful

QUEBEC (CP)—A royal commission report said here Edmund Asselin, now Liberal Member of Parliament for Montreal - Notre-Dame-de-Grace, made an "unlawful and unconscionable" personal profit of \$2,000 on a land deal with the Protestant school board of Greater Montreal.

The report said Mr. Asselin and partner Frank Spenard had no legal right to buy a property at St. Leonard de Port Maurice and sell it to the board at the profit they did since they had entered an agent relationship with the board.

This had been done when Mr. Asselin asked board chairman John Rowat for information about what property the board might be interested in, acquired it and passed it on to Mr. Spenard.

"In such circumstances, it was the duty and legal obligation of Asselin and Spenard to endeavor faithfully to obtain a property satisfactory to the board at the lowest possible price and to make full and complete disclosure to the board of all material facts pertaining to the transaction," the report said.
