**Drug Found For Cure Of Old Disease**

MONTREAL (CP) — Ciba Company Ltd., a subsidiary of Ciba Ltd., of Basle, Switzerland, announced Tuesday that research carried out by the parent firm had produced a drug that will cure schistosomiasis, a parasitic disease which it said has 200,000,000 victims in the Far East, the Middle East, Africa, South America and the West Indies.

The Ciba Co. of suburban Dorval said the drug was developed after long research and had been successfully tried on 2,000 infected persons.

The drug is being introduced in Africa. Three tablets a day for seven days eliminates the disease effectively and without discomfort to the patient, the company said.

The disease, spread by parasite-bearing water snails, has been a human affliction for centuries and traces of the parasites have been found in 3,000-year-old Egyptian mummies. The announcement said.

Many victims suffer complications of the liver, spleen and bronchi, or damage to the brain and spinal cord. Children are more vulnerable than adults.

Schistosomiasis is virtually unknown in Canada but U.S. authorities believe there are some 70,000 Puerto Ricans in New York city who are infected.

**Mineral Output In Territories Due To Increase**

OTTAWA (CP)—Mineral production in the Northwest Territories will rise to an estimated \$70,000,000 in 1966 compared with \$17,234,800 in 1964, Northern Affairs Minister Laing said Thursday.

"I am confident that this is just the beginning of a series of spectacular yearly increases in the Territories as a whole," the minister said in a Christmas message to northerners. About \$20,000,000 was spent in mineral exploration during this year and significant new deposits had been outlined.

Some deposits, including the big iron ore find on Ruffin Island, had reached the point

where decisions must be taken on whether to go into production. The northern education system was improving in the job of upgrading capabilities of young northerners. "I will be making a major statement in this regard in the near future," he promised. Mr. Laing reviewed previous announcements of a \$100,000,000 road program for the North and a \$12,000,000 housing scheme for Eskimos.

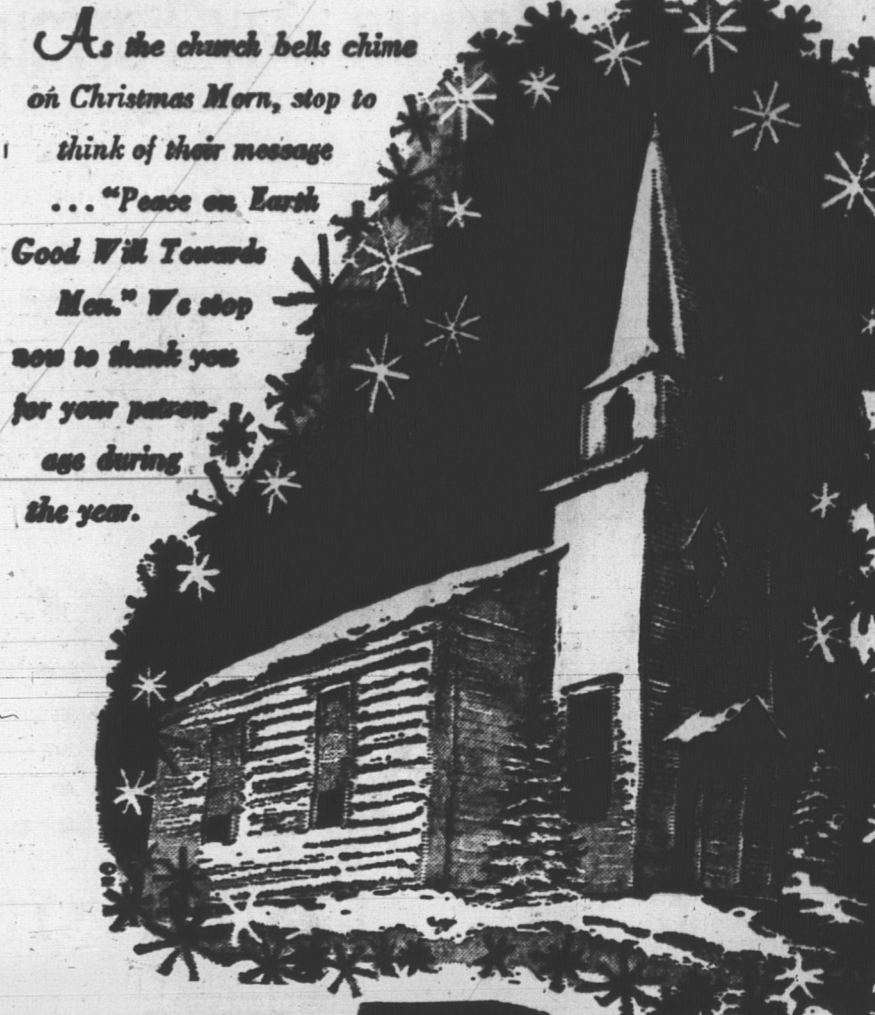
