THE VARIABLE CUE-BID

As a rule, a cue-bid of the opponents' suit announces a very strong hand, but there are exceptions.

North dealer

Both sides vulnerable

- Hand cards: A 4 3, Q 8 5, 8 4 2, 6 4 3 2

- Hand cards: Q J 9 8, 6, 7, 10 5, A K 10, 7 2

This deal came up in a team match, and the bidding at the first table was as follows:

Table with 4 columns: North, East, South, West. Shows bidding sequence: North Pass, East Pass, South Pass, West Pass.

West laid down the top club; South ruffed at Trick 2 and, playing the hand properly, made six-odd.

The North player at the other table was more imaginative. He made a huge contribution to this bidding:

Table with 4 columns: North, East, South, West. Shows bidding sequence: North Pass, East Pass, South Pass, West Pass.

Observe the vastly different effect of the four-heart bid at Table 1 and the three-spade bid at Table 2. In the first case South could not think about going further.

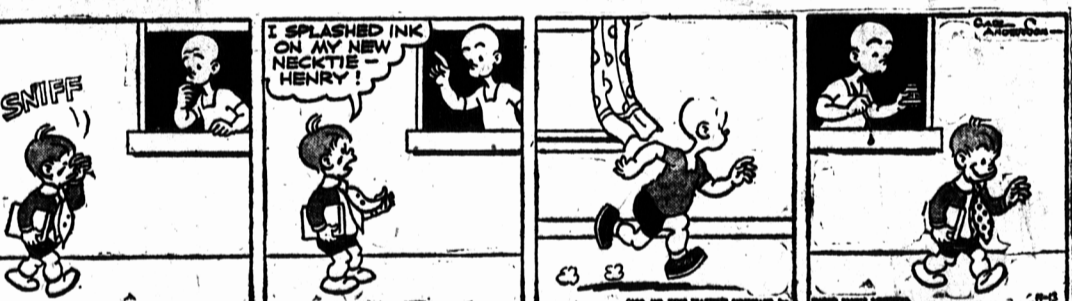
