**Police Chief Is Acquitted**

MONTREAL (CP) — Georges Beaulne, former police chief of Lafleche, Que., has been acquitted of perjury charge dating from testimony he gave during a court appearance in 1964.

Sessions Judge Jacques Anctil Monday upheld a defence contention that the Crown had failed to prove the charge beyond all reasonable doubt.

A defence lawyer, Paul Papineau, said Mr. Beaulne in a 1964 appearance was asked by a lawyer whether he had ever been convicted of a criminal offence. Mr. Beaulne answered the question in the negative, Mr. Papineau said.

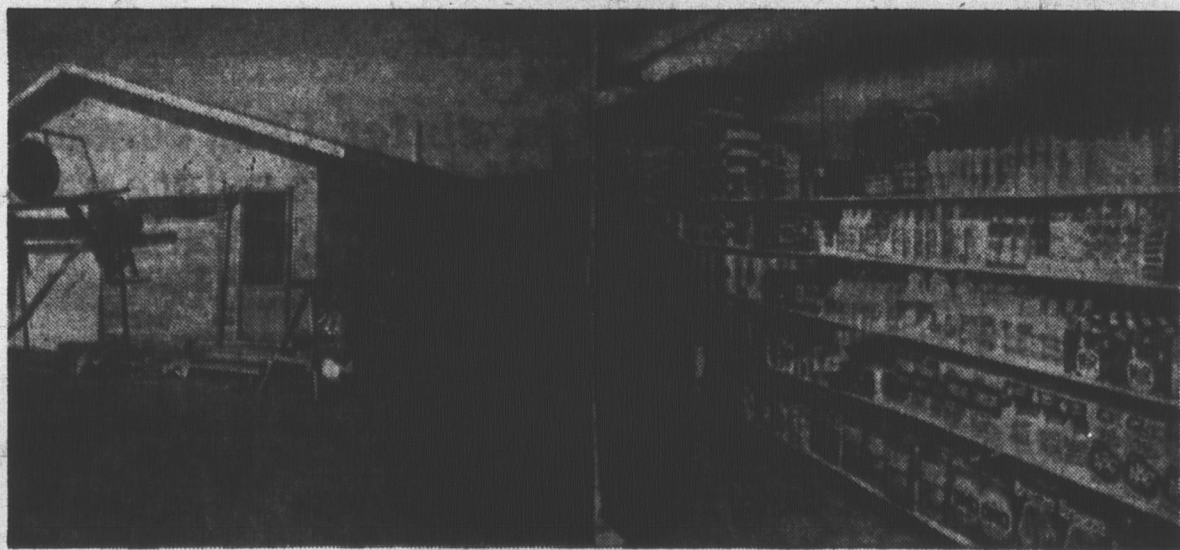

**Students Claim Housing Short**

HALIFAX (CP) — Students in Halifax and St. John's, Nfld., face housing shortages described Tuesday as serious and in some cases desperate.

some 2,800 out-of-town students among its enrolment of 4,000. Three campus residences are booked to capacity along with about 180 boarding houses listed by university authorities as approved for students.

Six new residences with room for 700-800 students will not open until January.

In Halifax, Leonard Rambeau of St. Mary's University student council president, said the uni-

versity's housing problem is desperate with 200 students searching for accommodation. He blames some city landlords "who don't want students at all." Saint Mary's enrollment has swelled to 1,050 this year from 800 last year.

In an effort to place students before classes begin, Roman Catholic clergy have announced the university's needs during church services.

At Dalhousie University, Student Council President John Young is optimistic that the university's housing will be able to place a final 200-225 students. "We're concerned but not desperate," he said.

GOVT. OFFICIAL DIES
