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### Conflicting Views On Soviet Protestations

**LONDON (CP)**—A conflict of views over Russia's intentions has been a feature of the opening phase of the conference of Commonwealth prime minister . . . Prime Minister Nehru of India feels broadly that Russia—despite events in Hungary—is still groping slowly toward a more liberal approach in world affairs. Prime Minister Menzies of Australia disagrees in a blunt speech, spiced with some sarcasm, he demands proof of any Soviet change of heart. For one thing, how about a Russian gesture on German reunification? . . . Most of the other eight prime ministers, or deputies, more or less support the Australian view. **SIMILAR PATTERN**  
The pattern is reminiscent of the last conference of Commonwealth premiers exactly a year ago. Then India, supported by Ceylon's Prime Minister Solomon Bandaranaike, pleaded for a greater effort to try to understand Russian problems. The other representatives warned against placing too much dependence on what seemed to be a "softer" Russian foreign policy. Menzies, something of an elder statesman at Commonwealth conferences, is seen as forcing the pace. He wants the final communique, issued next week, to be vigorously worded. If India can't subscribe to the general sentiments, perhaps there should be a minority report.  
Canadian Premier John Diefenbaker has also criticized Russia. It is understood he condemns Russia's tactics of subversive infiltration. Why, he asks, cannot Russia and the neighboring countries live in harmony, as Canada and the United States have for so many years.  
**INDIA ISOLATED**  
South Africa has attacked Communist attempts to penetrate strongly upholds the Baghdad pact as a barrier against communism. India, however, believes such pacts are among the chief causes of tension.  
India thus appears somewhat isolated in her views on the cold war, though she can undoubtedly count on Ceylon's support.  
Nehru thinks the time is ripe for a new psychological approach to Russia. He agrees Hungary
